

## New Pre-Licencing Education Program

The new pre-licencing program comes into effect January 2, 2014. Students enrolled in the existing program prior to January 2, 2014 will continue with the existing program and are required to complete the law and appraisal courses. The time limit to complete each module including the examination is four months.

Please see the chart below which details the changes from the existing “phase” program to the new “module” program.
